To Amend By-law 193-83 being a by-law for the regulation of traffic

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of The City of Brampton deems it expedient and advisable to amend By-law 193-83 being a by-law for the regulation of traffic;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of The City of Brampton hereby ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 193-83, as amended, is hereby further amended by the addition to Schedule XIII thereof the following items under the appropriate columns thereof:

DESIGNATED TURNING LANES

<u>COLUMN 1</u> <u>Highway</u>	<u>COLUMN 2</u> <u>Between</u>	<u>COLUMN 3</u> <u>Lane</u>	<u>COLUMN 4</u> <u>Direction</u>	<u>COLUMN 5</u> <u>Compulsory Turn</u>
Bramalea Road	Avondale Blvd. & Orenda Road	Centre	Northbound & Southbound	Left Turn


2. This by-law shall not come into force until approved by the Council of The Regional Municipality of Peel.
