Brampton, Bramalea Inc.)


WHEREAS Le Cercle de L'Amitié Brampton Bramalea Inc.
proposes to operate a bingo lottery on the dates set out in Schedule A
to this by-law:

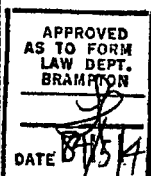
NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of
Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. Subsection 1 (1) of the Lord's Day (Ontario) Act (R.S.O. c.253, as amended) is hereby declared to apply in the City of Brampton between 4:00 o'clock and 6:30 o'clock in the afternoon, on the days set out in Schedule A to this by-law, in respect of the bingo lottery to be conducted by Le Cercle de L'Amitié Brampton Bramalea Inc., at 190 Hwy. # 7 West, Units 29 - 42.
2. All activities permitted by this by-law shall be conducted in an orderly manner.
