

**Notice of Intention to Amend “Tariff of Fees By-Law with Respect to Planning and Other Municipal Applications” (By-Law 85-96)
Minor Amendment Process for the
Main Street North Development Permit System**

Pursuant to By-law 160-2004, as amended, take notice that at its meeting on **Wednesday, August 9, 2023, at 9:30 a.m.**, in the Council Chambers at City Hall (with the option of electronic participation), City Council will consider a proposed amendment to Schedule A of the Tariff of Fees By-Law with Respect to Planning and Other Municipal Applications (By-Law 85-96, as amended).

Proposed By-law Amendment:

The proposed amendment is to add a fee for an application to request a minor amendment from the **Main Street North Development Permit System**. As set out below, the proposed fee is \$2,832, which is the same fee as a minor variance application. The approval process would be the same as for a Zoning By-law Amendment application, with a public meeting, following the same notification requirements, with City Council having final decision-making authority.
