## TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE

### Queen Street East (north side) between Main Street and Theatre Lane/Chapel Street


Contract: Downtown Brampton Streetscape Project Start Date: September 9<sup>th</sup>, 2024 End Date: December 24<sup>th</sup>, 2024 \*Timeline is subject to change.

The City of Brampton will be starting the Downtown Brampton Streetscape work along Main Street between Nelson Street and Wellington Street, and Queen Street between Mill Street and Chapel Street. This project is part of the Council-approved direction to Revitalize the Downtown Core.

The work involves widening of existing sidewalks with new granite pavers, narrowing roadways to one lane in each direction and resurfacing the pavement, constructing semi-mountable granite curbs with 1.5m wide bicycle lane, installing new moveable planter, installing new street furniture (i.e. benches) and replacing six traffic signals with new components.

Due to the active construction on Queen Street East, the road will be reduced to one eastbound lane of traffic between Main Street and Theatre Lane/Chapel Street, effective as early as 7:00am on September 9<sup>th</sup>, 2024, to the end of December 2024. Motorists are reminded to abide by traffic/construction/detour signs posted in local areas to ensure the safe travel of all local road users, pedestrians, and cyclists.

## **Construction Impact**

<u>Please note that construction will take place at various times between 2024 and 2027, and not for the entire duration of the contract. Work will be phased and require segmented closures on one side of the street.</u>

#### WORK DETAILS

The contractor will:

- Reduce Queen Street East to one eastbound lane of traffic between Main Street and Theatre Lane/Chapel Street.
- Maintain pedestrian access to businesses on north side of Queen Street.

#### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- The community will experience dust, noise and traffic delays.
- The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. Your patience is appreciated
